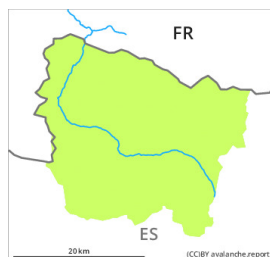
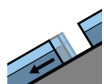


## Danger Level 1 - Low



**Tendency: Constant avalanche danger** →

Gliding snow



Wet snow



**Wet and gliding snow represent the main danger.**

A clear night will be followed in the early morning by favourable avalanche conditions generally. From the middle of the day small and, in isolated cases, medium-sized gliding avalanches and moist snow slides are possible. The avalanche prone locations are to be found on very steep sunny slopes in all altitude zones and on grassy slopes.

### Snowpack

In the next few hours the weather will be very warm.

Near-ridge shady slopes: In many places there is a danger of falling on the hard snow surface. Sunny slopes: The surface of the snowpack will freeze to form a strong crust and will soften during the day.

Above approximately 2000 m there are 100 to 200 cm of snow, and even more in some localities. Snow depths vary greatly at elevated altitudes, depending on the influence of the wind.

### Tendency

Thursday: Gradual decrease in danger of gliding avalanches and moist snow slides as the temperature drops.
