




The conditions are spring-like. Wet and gliding snow require caution.

The early morning will see favourable avalanche conditions generally. As the day progresses as a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation there will be a gradual increase in the danger of wet and gliding avalanches to level 2 (moderate). All aspects: These can to an increasing extent be released by people or triggered naturally. This applies in particular in the regions with a lot of snow at the border to Benasque and at the border to Ribagorça and Pallars.

### Snowpack

In particular east, south and west facing slopes as well as below approximately 2500 m: The surface of the snowpack will freeze to form a strong crust and will soften earlier than the day before. Shady slopes high altitudes: The snowpack is well consolidated and its surface consists of surface hoar.

Backcountry tours should be started and concluded early. Caution is to be exercised in areas with glide cracks.

## Tendency

Further increase in danger of wet and gliding avalanches as the moisture increases.
