Danger Level 1 - Low



Tendency: Constant avalanche danger _____ on Wednesday 31 01 2024

The avalanche conditions are mostly favourable. Gliding avalanches and moist snow slides during the day are possible now only in isolated cases.

As the day progresses as a consequence of warming during the day and solar radiation there will be only a slight increase in the danger of moist snow slides. Extremely steep grassy slopes and steep terrain that is interspersed with rocks: In addition a latent danger of gliding avalanches exists. The avalanches are rather small.

Snowpack

Sunny slopes: The surface of the snowpack will freeze to form a strong crust and will soften during the day. Shady slopes: The snowpack is well consolidated and its surface has a resilient crust. In steep terrain there is a danger of falling here. High Alpine regions: The upper section of the snowpack is dry and has faceted crystals on the surface.

Above approximately 2000 m there are 40 to 50 cm of snow. At low altitude from a snow sport perspective, insufficient snow is lying.

Tendency

Wednesday: The avalanche danger will persist.
