




# Early and late morning: Wet snow requires caution. Midday and afternoon: New snow above approximately 2000 m.

As a consequence of the precipitation moist and wet avalanches are to be expected as the day progresses, even medium-sized ones. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular on steep slopes below approximately 2500 m.

Midday and afternoon: As the snowfall level drops small dry avalanches are to be expected above approximately 2000 m. These can in some cases be released by people.

## Snowpack

The surface of the snowpack is not frozen and will soften quickly.

Up to 2500 m rain will fall in the early morning over a wide area. Above approximately 2000 m snow will fall from midday. 10 to 15 cm of snow will fall until late in the night above approximately 2000 m. Above approximately 2000 m there are 40 to 60 cm of snow, and even more in some localities. At low altitude from a snow sport perspective, insufficient snow is lying.

## Tendency

Saturday: Gradual decrease in danger of moist avalanches as the temperature drops.
